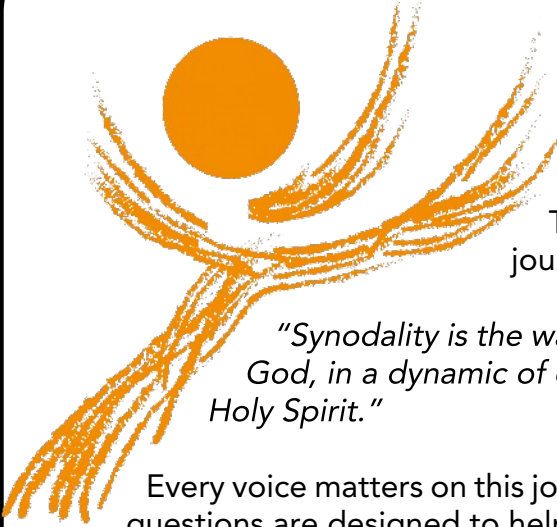


Share your thoughts

2. What gives you joy in belonging to your Parish or community?


3. When we say "our Church", who is part of it – and who is missing? What areas of mission might we need to develop?
