

The Last Supper

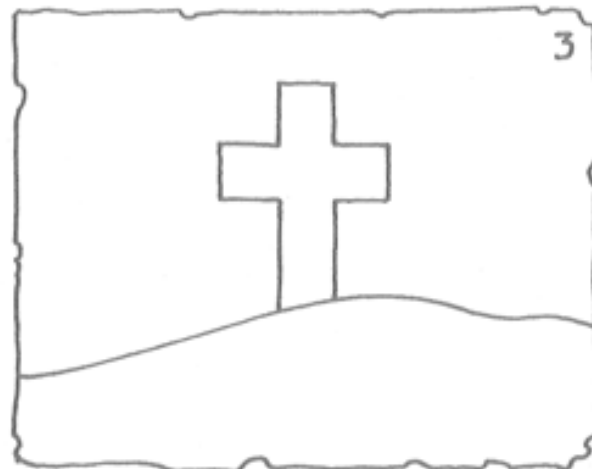
Jesus and his Apostles celebrated a Passover meal the night before he died. It was his Last Supper.

This is my body."



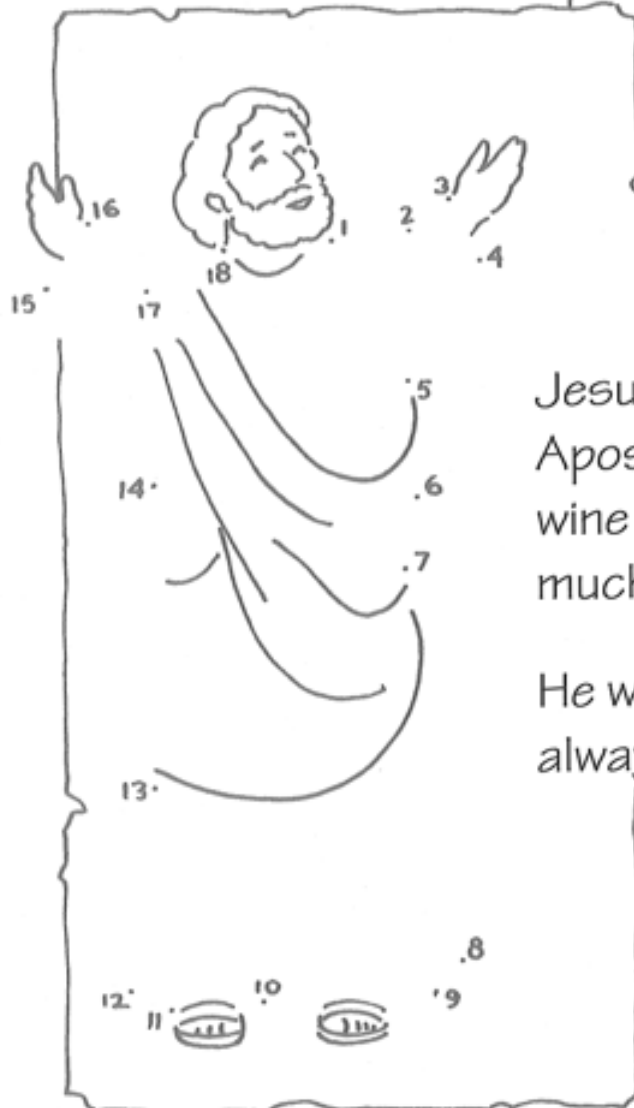
Later he took a cup

all of you,

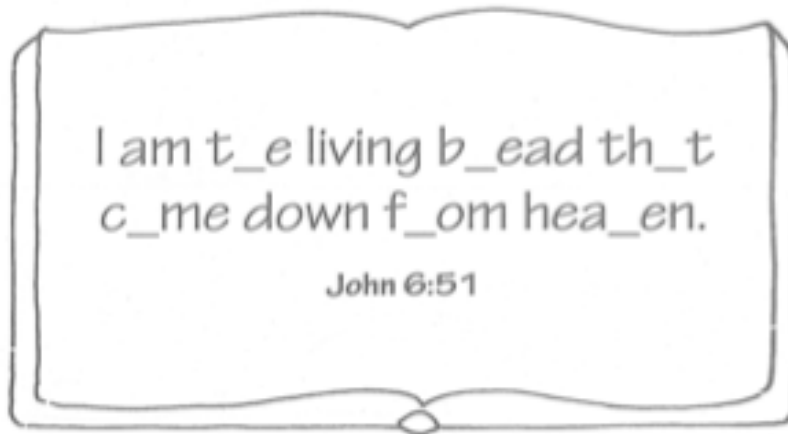
